

Terms and Conditions

1. The Targeted Support Bursaries are a financial offering of £1000 per academic year of study. A student must progress to their next level of study to continue to receive the bursary. If a student resits a year of study they will not receive the bursary but it will be reinstated once they have progressed to the next level.
2. The University offers 12 new bursary awards for each targeted support package and these are awarded on a first come, first served basis.
3. A student must submit both the completed application form and suitable evidence before a bursary can be awarded. If a student does not respond to requests for evidence then their application will not be considered.
4. The targeted support bursaries are available for home students, studying on a full time, undergraduate programme at Wrexham University only. Students at partner institutions are not eligible for the targeted support bursaries.
5. Students progressing to their next year of study will be required to have a 'check in' with Student and Campus Life to confirm their eligibility for the next payment award.

7. Awards cannot be claimed retrospectively for previous academic years.
8. Repayment of the award will not be required in the case of academic failure.
9. The University reserves the right to terminate awards in the case of disciplinary action taken against a student. This will be considered on an individual basis and communicated to the student.
10. Students must have funding in place to fund their tuition fees before a bursary will be awarded.
11. If a student has either tuition fees or accommodation fees debt with Wrexham University then the bursary will be halted until this fee is paid.
12. Students must meet with the Student Wellbeing Coordinator at the beginning of the academic year to receive their first bursary payment. Failure to do this may result in the bursary not being awarded. This will be communicated to the student.
13. Wrexham University reserves the right to request more evidence or information in relation to a student's application.
14. The bursary is paid in two cash payments per academic year. This will be paid into the bank account given in the student's application form. It is the responsibility of the student to confirm these details are correct.
15. Student and Campus Life will inform Wrexham Student Village of any students who are living in University owned accommodation and are therefore eligible for the accommodation discount. This is offered on a first come, first served basis and will be communicated to the student once applied.
16. Students cannot receive more than one targeted support bursary.
17. If a student suspends their studies, bursary payments will not be paid during the suspension. Once a student returns to their studies the bursary payments will resume.
18. The University has the right to check attendance for a student in receipt of a targeted support bursary and to halt any bursary payments if there are concerns regarding a student's engagement with their studies.
19. Part time students, international students, distance learning students, WU online students, postgraduate students and those on a degree apprenticeship are not eligible for a targeted support bursary.
20. If a student changes their studies, for example changes course or changes mode of study from full time to part time, then this will impact their eligibility for the financial support.
21. The student is responsible for keeping the University informed of any changes to their circumstances or studies which could impact their eligibility for the bursary.
