These courses will prepare you on both academic and professional levels to use Photoshop software to plan, develop, and integrate bitmap photographs and images in creative practice.

This essential level course allows you to explore Adobe Photoshop through a hands-on approach. You will be introduced to Visual Design Using Adobe Photoshop basic tools and features. This course will help you put your creative ideas into action by integrating theory and practice into tasks that prepare you for your future career in digital graphics.

You will learn using a hands-on practice that merges both theory and practice related to creating vector graphics. The course will be based on tasks that you are expected to have in your future career as a graphic designer.
