Adobe Premiere Pro is an essential tool for video experts and multimedia designers to take post-process and polish video projects. It is one of the top tools that allows you to modify video footage, apply video FX and merge several videos into a large multimedia production. Premiere Pro courses are in two main levels: Beginners and Advanced. These courses will prepare you on both academic and professional levels to use the software for video editing and post-production.

This Advanced course prepares you for the Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) exam through a hands-on approach. You will be introduced to advanced video editing and production using Adobe Premiere Pro. You will be introduced to the ACA exam, cover its different aspects, and break the ice through several practical questions.

This course will help you put your creative ideas into action by integrating advanced theory and practice into tasks that prepare you for your future career in digital video production.
