Indicative Assessment Tasks:

Assessment One: Learners will undertake an in-class test in the form of an MCQ quiz with approximately 20 questions to demonstrate what the RCN Prince of Wales Nursing Cadet Scheme involves and how it can enable young people to learn more about careers in health and social care (ILO1).

Assessment Two: Learner will deliver a 10 minute presentation that reflects on their delivery of an RCN Prince of Wales Nursing Cadet Scheme module to cadets (ILO2). The presentation will also identify how to be an effective role model to future cadets (ILO3). Finally the presentation will outline clear expectations targets for further development for higher education or next steps within career pathways (ILO4).
